Prospectus.

Children are received from 3 to 6 years of age, and may remain till they are 9.

The Instruction varies according to the age of the children.

Special care is bestowed on the Conduct and Physical Welfare of the pupils in attendance.

TERMS.

There are three Terms in the year, of about thirteen weeks each.

HOURS.

Morning, 9-30 to 12-30.

Afternoon, 2-30 to 4-0.

Wednesday is a Half-holiday.

Saturday is a Whole Holiday.

FEES.

Nine Shillings per Term, payable in advance.

Lunch (consisting of milk and biscuit), 3s. per Term.

I.—Parents are requested to make all necessary arrangements on the day before the Term begins, when the Head-Mistress will be in attendance at the School from 2-0 to 5-0 p.m.

II.—Fees in advance for the whole Term must be paid on the day before the Term begins.

III.—Regularity and punctuality of attendance must be strictly observed. A satisfactory note of explanation as to the cause of absence of any child must be sent to the Head-Mistress by the Parent or Guardian.

IV.—A form (supplied by the School) stating that a child has not been in contact with anyone suffering from infectious or contagious disease must be presented on the first day of each Term, signed by a Parent or Guardian.

V.—Children should be provided with a pair of indoor shoes, to prevent them from sitting in wet boots during School hours.

VI.—All articles of clothing (jackets, boots, shoes, umbrellas, &c.) should be marked with the owner's name.

Parents and Visitors are admitted to the School on Wednesday mornings between 9-30 and 12-30.
